###### 1 Coimbra University

Founded in Lisbon, in 1290, and transferred to the Royal Palace in Coimbra in 1537. We can highlight: "Iron Gate", Noble entrance to the Patio of the University. It dates from 1634.

###### 2 Machado de Castro National Museum / Roman Cryptoportus

Installed in an historical building – it was a Forum in the Roman period, a Christian Temple in the 11th century, an Episcopal Palace in the 12th century and a Museum since 1911. The museum was recently renovated and expanded, according to a project by the architect Gonçalo Byrne, being now a place where memories meet modernity.

More than one hundred pieces of its collections are classified as being of public interest, labelled as "National Treasures".

###### 3 Old Cathedral

Built in Romanesque style, it dates from 1162. Gothic cloister, the oldest one in Portugal. Remarkable set of sculptures and tombstones dating from the 12th, 14th and 16th centuries. The Sacrament Chapel dates from the 16th century and it was made by João de Ruão. St. Peter's Chapel, also from the 16th century, was made by Nicolau Chantrenne. Retable of the Hispano-Arabic tiles from Pedro de Quijarro's Atelier, bought in Seville in 1503. "Especiosa" Door, made by João de Ruão in the 16th century.

###### 7 New Cathedral

Founded by the Jesuits in 1598, its facade has been built in two phases: one classical and the other one baroque. The retable of the choir, in gilt carved wood, dates from the end of the 17th century and it was made by Jerónimo Luis, who was also the author of the retables in the transept. The choir stalls, dating from the 17th century, are made of black wood and they have come from the Old Cathedral, as well as the Manueline baptismal font. The organs date from the 18th century and they are neo-classical.

###### 10 Church of Santa Cruz Monastery / National Pantheon

Founded in 1131 by the canons of Saint Augustin. The Chapter Hall and the structure of the church, both made by Diogo de Boutaca, date from the second half of the 16th century. Tombs of Kings Afonso Henriques and Sancho I, with lying statues made by Nicolau de Chantrenne. Pulpit made by Nicolau de Chantrenne, dating from 1521. Baroque organ dating from 1719/1724, made by the French woodcarver, Lorette. Manueline cloister (1517). Portal from 1523, by Diogo de Castilho, and sculptures by João de Ruão and Nicolau de Chantrenne. Triumphal Arch made by José do Couto in the beginning of the 19th century.
